



## Get up close and personal with a 300m freighter

### Useful Tips:

- Jump aboard a harbour cruise with NOVA cruises or Moonshadow Charters and be part of the action. Cruises will take you from the Harbour out into the open ocean, where playful dolphins are often spotted riding the boat's current. During the winter months whales can be seen showing off their magnificent fins as they migrate to warmer waters. Look out for the albino whale, well known among Novocastrians for its rare but awe striking visits.
- Take a ferry across to Stockton and walk the Stockton Shipwreck walk along the northern break-wall. You will see shipwrecks half immersed in the water right in front of you, and interpretive signs offer some interesting stories about their tragedy and Newcastle's maritime history. This is also a great vantage point to watch huge ships come into port.
