Useful Tips:

- Pick up a Newcastle map from the Maritime Centre at Honeysuckle, and check the tour times at Fort Scratchley to make a tour of the site or tunnels underground, a real highlight.
- Take a moment to stop and watch busy tugs and 300m freight ships navigate the harbour.
- Read the information signs along the way – there are some quirky facts to learn that will help you unravel Newcastle’s story.
- Stop for coffees throughout Newcastle East – the cafes are small, quirky and full of locals.
- Stop for a beer or wine at the View Factory Arts Café on Scott Street, and immerse yourself in our Byron Bay-like local music culture.
